## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the show giving club nor any of its members will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed of Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. OWNERS OR AGENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PRESENCE OF THEIR DOGS IN THE JUDGING RING.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The clubs, hotel, and any of their agents or employees will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

## ENTRY INFORMATION

**Entry fee per day:** (including AKC recording/event service fees)

All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **TBC/CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday March 15**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show.

**Fax/email entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both sides of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com and clicking on the PayPal/Credit Card link. **Payment must include the \$2.00 per class additional charge to be valid.**

**NEW!! Online Entry Service:** The new CAPER online entry system will be available as of March 1, perhaps earlier. See www.caper-dogs.com for information and updates.

**Entry Acknowledgements:** It is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

**Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of \$5 or less will not be refunded.**

**Transfers:** Entries which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, or the required number of wins in Junior Showmanship, after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class or the higher Junior Showmanship class. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary designate at least 30 minutes prior to the start of regular conformation judging at the show.

### Three reasons to get your entries in early!

- 1) Entry fee checks are not cashed until closing
- 2) There is NO CHARGE to change or cancel entries before closing
- 3) Armband numbers are assigned randomly, not by order of entry receipt

### Best Puppy (each show)

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that puppy will automatically win Best Puppy.

### Best Bred by Exhibitor (Saturday Show #1 only)

First place in each Bred by Exhibitor class will compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If a BBE entry is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that entry will automatically win Best Bred by Exhibitor.

## SWEEPSTAKES (Friday only)

Sweepstakes is open to all Bulldogs who are 6 months but less than 18 months old on the day of the sweepstakes. Dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class, with age division, in the space provided for Additional Classes on the entry form. Champions of record are NOT eligible to compete. Professional handlers may show their own dogs only.

### DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

35% of total entry fees will be retained by Club for expenses.

The remaining 65% will be awarded as follows:

1st Place in each class - 40% of class entry	3rd Place in each class - 20% of class entry
2nd Place in each class - 30% of class entry	4th Place in each class - 10% of class entry

All cash prizes rounded to nearest dollar amount. Undistributed funds revert back to TBCWF.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (Saturday only)

**Novice class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Open class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

**Master class:** For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the **front and back** of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES (Saturday only)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

\* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are de-fined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler.

## ROUTES TO THE SHOW

DO NOT bathe dogs in hotel rooms or use towels for grooming / clean-up purposes. Use heavy plastic under crates. ALL HOTELS REQUIRE that dogs be crated when owners are not in the room.
